Objective : •for Children
This activity creates the opportunity to motivated coming back their home town,
Mitsuke for working in near future.
At a time when the labor force is shrinking because of the falling birth rate and the aging population,
secure the necessary personnel is important in this area.
Career experience makes them clear to set their goals for the career plans.
The ages children places more expectation on their future career,
and make it more clear by experiencing the job.
Through the career experience,
they may learn multiple images to the job.
Through the experience,
children can set / reconfirm their own goals for the future
which may create the change of their mind to the positive side.

it makes children enough period of reflection for their futures.

Results : <> Purpose was achieved

for Children

Children had experiences with the occupation longing and **dreams in the future**. The experiences aroused their interests for jobs and let them stay motivated of activities.

for Sponsors

By touching the serious attitude of the children, they re-realized their own jobs as longed-for jobs. This let them **rediscover** their responsibility as the public institutions.

for JCI Mitsuke

1) Sponsors voluntary provided some **gifts** to the children which memorize the career experience made children happy.

Recommendations : Considerations In case keeping this activity constantly, below measures should be taken in order to solve the oversubscription. a) Recruit more sponsors by describing the activities well to them. b) Extend the implementation period.
 2) Prepare a line of communication to the parents in case of emergency. In this activity there was no problem caused, however it is required to prepare the line of communication to the parents not only supporting by only staffs in case of emergency (i.e. sudden illness).
 Recommendations By the sponsors donation etc, the cost would be only conference place fee. So you <u>can run the project even small LOM less budget</u>.
 We gifted pictures to the children. For running smoothly, we should plan the camera angles before.

♦Human rights

Article 22 of the constitution of japan: <u>Every person shall have freedom</u> to choose and change his residence and to choose his occupation to the extent that it does not interfere with the public welfare.

♦Labor standards

We targeted the affirmative action plan by <u>easing wrong assumption to the careers</u>. So providing various kinds of careers experience give the children good chance to <u>deeply know the careers</u>.

♦Environmental

We insist to <u>save using air conditioner</u> by intensify activities to raise awareness for ecology.


That the 111 in whom children aged 10-12 in the activity area

Award Category criteria 6 • Letting children experience this project, we believe to be able to set up a trigger that children going away to learn the technology of occupation come back to Mitsuke in the future. • We want to promote a **positive mind** for building a more attractive Mitsuke in cooperation with JCI Mitsuke, local companies and citizens. • For the project purpose description against career experience implementation companies and local governments of this time, it was 6 months before the implementation of the project, but to start the visit from the earlier period, through the extension of the project implementation period by increasing the sponsor number get approval, it will be able to get the career experience to many children as possible. It is considered as one of the improvements also be provided an opportunity to **announce** to the citizens of the Mitsuke region reports through career experience of children. However, children are required the cooperation of all 11 elementary schools activities and the construction area of practice meeting report presented at each elementary schools.



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
