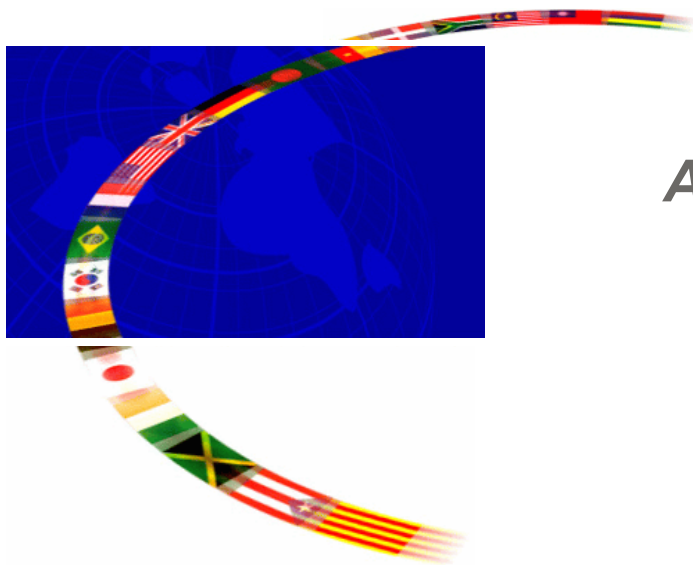

- Results : 862 Junior high school students in Niigata city took part in this activity.
99.8 % of them could understand the contents of this event.
98.4 % of them could plan to make their own carriers through the discussion with lecturers.

- Recommendations : **We achieve the student participants goal**, but did not achieve the school participants goal.
The reason why the latter goal was not achieved, is the mis-scheduling and the changes in teachers.
