- Overview: Held a public meeting in 2008, the aim of regional development of the citizen-led rather than government dependency.  - Event is a half marathon, 10 km, 5 km, 2,5 km, parent-child pairs . Japan Association of Athletics Federations official meeting.
 - It invited a famous marathon runner in the guest runner. Held Kitami Gourmet Street lined with stalls that can enjoy the local autumn taste in the venue. We are planning a meeting in which both of the runners and the audience can enjoy.

- Results : 1. Citizens participating in the executive committee can take proactive actions in order to better their community.
 - 2. It becomes an event to represent the region, and contribute to the vitalization of the region.
 - 3. The number of runners has increased to about 2,500, half of them are people who live outside the region and have brought great economic benefits.
 - 4. It has led to widely appeal to the charm of the Kitami.
 - 5. 400 or more sets of parent and child competed in the event of the parent-child pairs. It has contributed to the growing of the familial love.

Held a public meeting. Kitami Half-Marathon as concrete ideas for vitalizing the region is proposed.

[2009]

Kitami HalfMarathon Executive Committee established. The Executive Committee was held 21 times. Kitami Half-Marathon 1st Annual Meeting was held.

[from 2010 to 2015]

We were held to continue the Executive Committee and held Kitami Half-Marathon 2nd to 7th Annual Meeting. The number of runners has increased to more than 2500 people, it was expanded to more than 100 people also Executive Committee members. We've been successful in expanding the scale of the tournament by deepening the trust relationship through the cooperation of the government and civil society organizations and a number of companies.
