Objective: JCI Nagano acts with the following purposes; 1. We encourage the transformation of awareness of cross-cultural exchange of citizens, and positive changes in their minds. 2. We support and collaborate with groups for international interactions as a leading organization with global network in order to develop citizen activities on international interactions.

Overview: JCI Nagano held \"The 2016 NAGANO International Festa\" targeted at foreign residents and Japanese citizens of the city. The event was held with the aim of increasing chances for citizens to have positive communications, as well as to create an opportunity for international interaction groups to interact with each other, and to make a step in establishing the international city Nagano where multiple cultures coexist. - A forum for International interaction This forum was held to lead to mutual understanding on multiple culture coexistence through a panel discussion about the experience of interactions. Japanese participants and participants from other countries felt close to the international interaction and overcame differences of language, culture, and customs. -Intercultural Exchange promotion program This program was intended to encourage active communication for international interactions from

multiple cultures. Participants that have trouble getting to know each other because of language barriers enjoyed interactions in a party through various activities and deepened their understanding of other cultures. Results: JCI Nagano has achieved the following objectives. - Number of

participants in NAGANO International Festa Total participants: 467 foreign residents and citizens (211 foreign residents and 227 citizens) Because many foreign residents participated in this event, we were also able to promote JCI activities widely to non-Japanese people. We succeeded in making positive changes in the awareness of cross-cultural exchange of foreign residents as well as Japanese citizens. Verification of encouraging positive exchanges through this project According to the questionnaire, 93 percent of the Japanese and foreign participants answered that they had positive interactions, which is an accomplishment. 99 percent of participants said they enjoyed the international interaction activity through this project. We received feedback that they wished this kind of event would continue in the future. * Cooperation with international interaction groups Through this project to improve awareness of citizens for international interactions, we carried out it in cooperation with international interaction groups. We held several meetings with them to understand each other. Because of the cooperation with such international interaction groups, we succeeded in expanding the awareness of the importance of international interactions and such activities to the citizens in order to realize the international city Nagano for future.
