According to a questionnaire of citizens about a local problem conducted
by Sapporo City, 3 faculties below were called as local problem.
- Decreasing birthrate and aging population
- Protection against disaster
- Revitalizing local community
In detail of "Protection against disaster", many citizens pointed below.
- Action for continuous support to restore from serious disaster
- Strengthen an ability to minimize the damage from disaster through
mutual help between citizens.
Based on the questionnaire, JCI Sapporo decided to grow awareness of
mutual help and started finding what we can do.
After starting, on 14-16 Apr 2016, a big earthquake happened in Kumamoto.
The earthquake in Kumamoto damaged huge area from Kumamoto, had a
magnitude of 7.3, killed 204 people, and injured 2727 people.
After the earthquake, in was pointed that suffered children were in

danger of getting PTSD.

So, JCI Sapporo invited suffered children from disaster area to Sapporo and made opportunity to decrease their stress and to recover mental stability through sightseeing.

And JCI Sapporo made an opportunity for Sapporo citizens to notice the importance of consideration for others and to recognize that mutual help is one of solution to local problems by the interaction of children in Kumamoto and Sapporo.

By the way, according to an investigation by a private company, Sapporo is the 3rdbest attractive city in Japan. But Sapporo is located 1500km far from Kumamoto, so it is hard for children in Kumamoto to visit Sapporo without some special reason.

JCI Sapporo visited Kumamoto Prefecture and looked for participants with JCI Kumamoto, JCIAso, JCI Beppu, and JCI Kumamoto block conference. As a result, 10 children in Kumamoto wanted to join this project.

And 10 children in Oita, a prefecture next to Kumamoto, also joined this project in cooperation with JCI Oita.

20 children from Kumamoto and Oita did homestay for 4days in 9 houses in Sapporo.

The children went sightseeing with their host family and learned some culture on Sapporo.

And the children also joined a festival made by JCI Sapporo and interacted with Sapporo citizens.

Sapporo citizens came to know a situation of the disaster area and children's mental stability by homestay in Sapporo.

Sapporo citizens felt the importance of mutual help by stories told by suffered children.

At the same time, citizens came to understand that the "Mutual help" is one of the solution to local problems in Sapporo.

JCI Sapporo did crowdfunding to give opportunity to join this homestay project for citizens that are not host family.

By this crowdfunding 20 children invitation was achieved.

JCI Sapporo raised a donation for disaster area at the local festival made by ourselves.

JSI Sapporo made citizens people that has ability to help each other actively.

1. When we start this homestay project, there was no house that can be a host. So, JCI Sapporo asked some families to be host.

2. According to questionnaire after this homestay project, not only participants from Sapporo but also participants from Kumamoto and Oita came to want to be host family in the future.

3. After this project some participants from Sapporo visited Kumamoto and went to a house of a child that they had accepted.

4. Now the interaction between children and parents in Sapporo, in Kumamoto and in Oita.

5. By accepting children as homestay, Sapporo citizens changed their mind to be glad to help suffered people actively.

Objective achieved

1. JCI Sapporo could have children in Sapporo realize the importance of mutual help because 60% of host parents answered that they could see such change in their children' s mind.

2. JCI Sapporo could have Sapporo citizens realize the importance of help suffered people because, on questionnaire, 100% participants came to want to be host at homestay project in the future.

3. JCI Sapporo provided an opportunity for Sapporo citizens to take action actively for the others through crowdfunding and donation.

4. By crowdfunding JCI Sapporo collected US\$3,000 from 57 people though US\$2,500 was aimed.120% was achieved.

5. JCI Sapporo sent US\$262 by donation to suffered area through JCI Japan.

6. JCI Sapporo succeeded to change Sapporo into a city in that citizens take action actively to improve the local community through giving opportunity for Sapporo citizens to notice the importance of mutual help.

7. By articles of national newspapers, the objective and results of this project is known to people all over Japan.

Objective not achieved

1. While planed host family recruiting period no family applied. Because JCI Sapporo didn't show a preparation for unexpected accidents and parents felt uneasy to accept children from Kumamoto or Oita.

2. Direct participants of this project in citizens ware only host family.

How to Improve

1. Make a guideline to join easily for participants and host.

2. Providing opportunities for Sapporo citizens who are not host to join this project.
