Overview: We ,JCI Shodoshima, did an discussion event as World Café (or Knowledge Cafe) style. Usually Japanese do not like discussion openly. Especially natives and migrants in Shodoshima Island do not communicate with each other. We provide opportunity to communicate and discuss about the problem in the community very openly. World Cafe Method is very suiltable for this type discussion. World Cafe is a type of business meeting or organisational workshop which aims to provide an open and creative conversation on a topic of mutual interest to surface their collective knowledge, share ideas and insights, and gain a deeper understanding of the subject and the issues involved. Facilitator, Ms Masumi Tani, raised a question that In the future what is better life in this island? This question inpspired the participants to discuss each other objectively. It also create bond with participants. \\\"

Results: Natives and migrants communicated with each other and made mutual understanding. They have shared the problems of Shodoshima Island and share basement of solutions. Some participants made some relationship for their business. This event is just a beginning and it ocurrs many influence to participants.

Actions Taken: - We made the group page on Facebook (called migrants\\\' network). It makes network of participants and distribute information. - We requested emigrants to participate the event by some handouts. - The event was informed to citizens by PR agencies of the both town. - Press release in press club. - Members of the committee searched emigrants and requested them to participate the event. - We requested delegates of neiborhood assosiation and owners of real estate as native participants.

Recommendations: In both survey and interviews, there are many requests to do this event again. Some participants said there were no enough time to discuss deeply and I want to talk more people. We thing this event should be repeated and expanded in the next year. This event is only beggining. It provided the opportunity to change both natives and migrates to think about meaning of migrates and problems around them. This changes will be big impact if we continuously take action to create opportunity to make good communication between natives and migrates.
