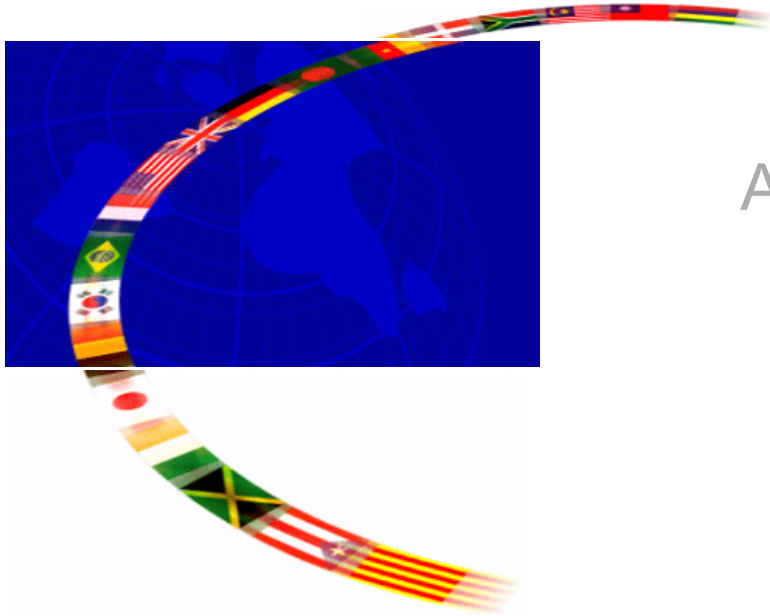

Who is benefited ? : Starts from Osaka for business people, companies, associations. For next generation business people.

Objective : TOYP stands for [The Outstanding Young Persons], referring to young persons who are engaged in praiseworthy activities. TOYP aim to engage in international exchanges with outstanding representatives of the younger generation who are exerting their social influence in various areas, to learn from each other and to raise awareness of each others activities.

Our objectives are:

1. For JCI Osaka members, it is a step toward to be a leading global network.
2. For Osaka citizens, it is an opportunity to create positive change.

Overview : Assemble five outstanding young persons from overseas, and have workshop, civic forum in which five members make presentations in their activities and run a panel discussion with these five members.

1) Study and research

We conducted surveys related to social problems. We studied what we need to cultivate for our future, and decided our TOYP theme as [Bond beyond the Generation].

Analyzing individuals, organizations, and companies playing an active role in the world, find out what is really important to pass on to next generations.

2) Selection of TOYP members

We collected information from the network of past TOYP members, embassies and consulates-general of various countries, NGOs, companies, and organizations. We selected five outstanding young people who exert influence to the world, and invited them to Japan.

3) Workshop

We provided to TOYP members an opportunity to understand what is considered to be important for some company in Japan. This year we chose Yamamoto chemical company attract attention worldwide.

4) TOYP forum

It is difficult to identify what we can do for the future, what kind of society can we provide for our children, when they reach maturity 20-30 years later from now? What role should we each play to fulfill our responsibilities as a person concerned in such a rapidly changing world? The TOYP program has addressed problems of global society and many local communities under themes varying every year, aiming at establishment of an international private network. We held a forum to provide Osaka citizens an opportunity to recognize that each of them are responsible for creating a future and have power to pass on to next generations.

5) Japanese culture experience program

Accept each other as they are, Try to do so, at least. All committee members in charge of TOYP have treated TOYP members who we invited to Japan kindly providing cordial hospitality [OMOTENASHI]. We have created opportunities for TOYP members, we have discovered cultural differences between countries. Every word that we produce has a historical and cultural background and meaning. We should recognize that we are part of the extension of history and culture.
