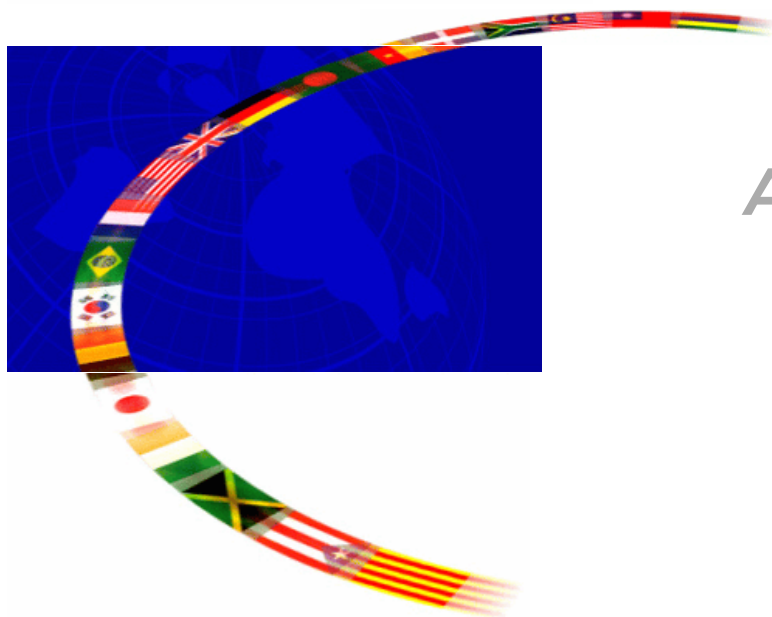

Who is benefited ? : Elementary school students who live in Shinagawa, elementary school students to live to live in Oshima. About its parents, people who live to live in Shinagawa each about 37 million people. People who live in Oshima-machi each about 8000.

Objective : Children in Shinagawa to understand the importance of communicating with people and the natural environment. This ensures that children will be to think about the future of Shinagawa. They tell to friends and family that the children have experienced actively, encouraging a change of mind of the people around family and family children in Shinagawa, and children of Oshima-machi play a central role.

Overview : Children in Shinagawa moved to Oshima. and experienced fishing in Oshima. Elementary school students and elementary school students Oshima-machi Shinagawa took the communication. They had experience in front of a group of people. Elementary school students who participated in the project, has announced that it has experienced in the students in a discussion format and principal teacher of the elementary school to which it belongs.

Results : Elementary school students who participated had a clean up and prepare meals aggressively. Elementary school students who participated learned the difference between Oshima natural environment remains as large as (city) town to live his own. Elementary school students who participated told actively to elementary school students and family and friends of knowledge that you learn about the natural environment, that you have experience in cooking and fishing. 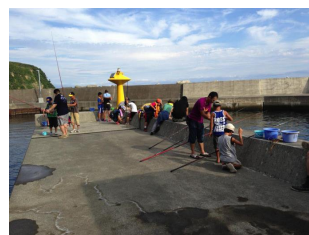
Objectives, Planning, Finance and Execution
