Summary of Homestay

We divided 10 elementary & middle school children in living at Kaizuka city area into 7 groups and each groups did homestay at family of living Taipei city area in 4 nights 5 days.

These 10 children learned the song of Chinese 朋友(ponyo) and sang this song together.
