> September10th, 2015~September30th, 2015 To invite students to apply for the"What is Great About Toyota City Contest" (aimed at 13,100 junior high school students and got 98 application forms)

September10th,2015~October30th,2015 Recruit supporting members from junior high school students.

October7th,2015 Trial meeting for the contest.

October10th,2015~October20th,2015 Investingate the places of the winning places(4field survey working with The Society for the Protection of Obara Four-Season Cherry)

October20th,2015~October30th,2015 Inviting the supporting members who wants to experience pruning the Four-Season Cherry in Obara town. Tovota Citv.

November5th,2015 Under the guidance of "The Society for the Protection of Obara Four-Season Cherry", members in the supporting group experienced the pruning.

November 20th, 2015 Summarized the activities and had a panel discussion in the monthly meeting.

Recommendations: A having a contest, it accomplished goal to re-knowing the grealness of Toyota city, but it was difficult to rank the difference and seemed to have no effect so as a result it would be better to change the contest into a presentation.

> As for the supporting group, experiencing the community culture makes the young generations to be interested in their hometown and havingbthese situation repeatedly will make them fond of their hometown and will want to live in it for a lifetime. We are confident about making them love their hometown, but the most important is to do continuously and it is necessary to make a structure.
