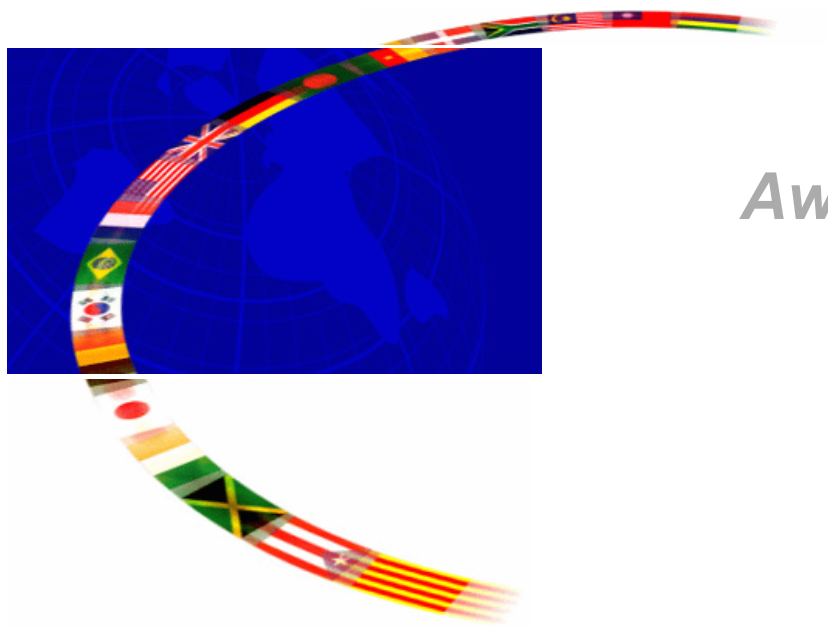

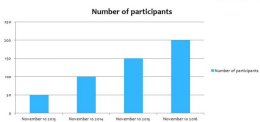
What is the expected long-term impact of this project?
